Board Highlights for the East Central Francophone Meeting August 25, 2020

COVID-19 Update

During the summer, central office staff worked to establish protocols and prepare plans so that each building and all staff can be compliant with hygiene and sanitary measures. Personal protective equipment, signage and disinfectant materials have been ordered and are being distributed to schools. CSCE is expecting the material provided by the Government on August 26. The protocols have been developed for school transportation and for janitorial staff. More hours have been added to our base contracts to allow for necessary disinfection during the pandemic. Since August 15, the four francophone school authorities in Alberta have been working to set up a K-9 virtual school attached to the CFÉD. We are in the process of identifying the teachers who will work in this setting and providing the necessary training. CSCE parents have until August 31 to register their child in CFED's virtual school. The Superintendent will meet with each of the school teams over the next few days to answer questions and concerns from staff in the context of

returning to school during the pandemic. The CSCE Re-launch Plan, Scenario 1 is available on the CSCE website.

Capital Maintenance Renewal Project Update

Each of the projects provided for in the Capital Maintenance Renewal funding is progressing very well and all major improvements will be completed by the start of the school year.
