Board Highlights for the East Central Francophone Meeting October 27, 2020

SCHOOL COUNCILS

The meeting between CSCE Trustees and School Council Chairs previously scheduled for November 24 has been postponed to January 26, 2021, at 3:30 pm. The purpose of this meeting is to review the amended administrative procedures as well as to provide the opportunity for School Council representatives to have an open dialogue with CSCE Trustees about the challenges and the opportunities that this school year presents.

SCHOOL RE-ENTRY GUIDE UPDATED

The CSCE school re-entry Plan was revised on October 14, 2020. It is available on the CSCE website.

ACCOUNTABILITY REPORT

The Accountability Pillar Summary Report summarizes the responses of students, teachers and parents in the satisfaction survey that was conducted in February 2020. The overall results remain constant and positive. It is important to note that there are no results for June 2020 on achievement tests and diploma exams, due to the pandemic. In general, everyone agrees that CSCE schools are safe and caring. In addition, each of the groups surveyed said they were satisfied or very satisfied that CSCE students were well prepared for the labour market. The number of students who qualify for the Rutherford Scholarship continues to be very high. Note that the parent response rate is relatively low in some schools. Each School Team will meet to discuss the results and develop local strategies to address the challenges.



UPDATE-INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECT

Video cameras are being installed at École du Sommet and École Beaux-Lacs. These are part of the *Capital Maintenance Renewal* funding received in May. Furthermore CSCE is waiting for a decision to be made on projects submitted in 2020-2021 round of funding.

PASTORAL LETTER

A pastoral letter received from the Bishops of Alberta announced that Catholic Education Sunday is scheduled for November 8. The theme is taken from the book of Isaiah: "Those who put their hope in the Lord find new strength. (Isaiah 40:31).

COLD LAKE AND PLAMONDON DAYCARE-FEASIBILITY STUDY

A feasibility study on the potential for childcare services provided in French in Cold Lake and Plamondon is taking place. It will help to determine the potential number of parents who need childcare services in French in both communities as well as to identify potential partners in these projects.

CSCE WARDS

School elections will be held in the fall of 2021. CSCE Trustees adopted a motion indicating that the status quo be maintained with regard to the CSCE electoral regions/wards for the up-coming School Board elections.
