Board Highlights for the East Central Francophone Meeting November 24, 2020

Financial Statements 2019-2020

Pierre Bergeron, of Bergeron & Co, presented the audited financial statements for the year 2019-2020. Revenues were \$17,259,209, expenses were \$16,918,985, leaving a surplus of \$340,224 which was attributed to the accumulated deficit of \$387,803.

Educational Annual Results

The report on annual results in education must consider, this year, a very specific situation due to Covid-19 and home learning from March 2020 to June 2020. Principals and teachers have been successful to adapt their teaching with the pursuit of their development in technology, of the transcription of lessons to a different model while having at heart the success but especially the mental health of the students and their families.
