### Board Highlights for the East Central Francophone Meeting October 14, 2021

#### Fall Conventions

The Board of Trustees determined the CSCE representatives at the annual conventions of the various education-related associations. Chairman Réginald Roy as well as trustees Colette Borgun and Danielle Larsen will participate in the convention of the National Federation of Francophone School Boards (FNCSF) which will be held from October 28 to 30, 2021. Colette Borgun will participate in the ASBA convention, from 14 to November 16, 2021. Danielle Larsen, for her part, will attend the ACSTA convention which will take place from November 12 to 14, 2021. Finally, Réginald Roy will attend the FCSFA convention on November 29, 2021.

#### Automated External Defibrillators

Administrative procedure 161 on automated external defibrillators was presented to the board of trustees. This new procedure regulates the use of these resuscitation devices which have been installed in the five schools of the council as well as at the central office.

#### Update – Pandemic Management

Superintendent Dolorèse Nolette reminded the newly elected trustees of the various steps taken by the management team, since the start of the school year, in relation to the management of Covid-19. She also mentions that at this time no school in the Centre-Est has an outbreak status.

#### Survey – Quality Assurance

Assistant Superintendent Josée Verreault made a presentation on the mission and the results targeted by Alberta Education as well as on the education plan created by the CSCE - *Vers 2025*. Josée Verreault also made a presentation of the results of the last survey on quality measures in education. Taking into account the challenges caused by the pandemic, the results of the Conseil scolaire Centre-Est are almost all above the provincial average.



## Health and Safety

Following the request of the Minister of Education to implement a vaccine proof policy, senior management sent an anonymous internal survey to staff. With the results of this survey obtained on October 13 and the supporting documents from the legal team, the management team will prepare a draft vaccine proof policy to present to the board of trustees in the coming weeks.
