Bill 15

The Minister of Education has tabled Bill 15 which addresses the process for handling complaints against the Code of Professional Conduct for ATA members and

members of the College of Alberta School Superintendent Act (CASS). The effective date of these changes could be January 1, 2023 if the bill is proclaimed within the announced timelines.

School Councils

The Trustees met with the school council chairs to review the activities and challenges that the pandemic has brought to the schools this year, particularly in terms of parent engagement. Nevertheless, many activities took place for the students.
