#### Policy 5.0 - Student and Staff Health and Wellness

Policy 5.0 - The Health and Wellness of Students and Staff - passed first reading. This policy follows the goals of the Vers 2025 education plan. It is intended to be a foundation document for the workplace and school wellness initiatives that are in development. The policy is based on the premise that well-being is defined in several dimensions and holistically. When these dimensions are in balance, an individual develops a sense of well-being. Another important principle is that health and well-being are both an individual and a collective responsibility. The policy is out for consultation before the 2nd and 3rd readings and will be available on our News page, on our website.

#### Schools Calendars 2023-2024

After consulting with our school communities, the superintendent presented a new draft calendar for the 2023-2024 school year. The calendar attempts to respect the wishes of parents to align major holidays with those of neighboring boards while still allowing CSCE to accomplish its goals. In order to meet Ministry of Education requirements, we must offer at least 178 days of instruction given the length of our school days. Calendars will be shared with the school community shortly.

#### **Infrastructures Investment**

CSCE proposes to develop outdoor learning areas for high schools as well as the development of the École Beauséjour playground base using IMR (Infrastructure Maintenance Renewal) and CMR (Capital Maintenance Renewal) deferred revenue. These projects will be completed by the end of summer 2023.

# **Changes - Meeting Dates**

A formal meeting in May will be scheduled with the school council chairs. Some changes have been proposed to the meeting schedule for elected trustees due to professional development activities for some members of the management team. The superintendent and board chair will be attending the National Education Summit on April 27 and 28 in Ottawa.
