Governance Policies

The Board of Trustees passed in second reading of Policy 5.0 Health and Wellness of Students and Staff after receiving input from the school community.

A review of Policies 2.0 - Board-Superintendent Relationship and 2.1 - Delegation to the Superintendent was also completed.

School Calendars 2023-2024

The final drafts of the 2023-2024 school calendars for du Sommet, Beaux-Lacs, Beauséjour, Voyageur, Ste-Catherine and CFÉD were adopted by the Trustees. The calendars were set at 195 days and include a short fall break, as well as a Christmas and spring break that are consistent with those of neighbouring boards. Capital Plan 2024-2027

The CSCE's three-year capital plan (2024-2027), which was prepared by the firm Juristes Power, was presented to the Board. Among the infrastructure priorities, the plan establishes these three main elements: Priority 1 - Modernization of the Beauséjour School in Plamondon, a priority that has been in the plans since 2008. Priority 2 - Acquisition of a building for École Ste-Catherine in Lac La Biche. Priority 3 - Expansion of École Voyageur in Cold Lake.
