The CSCE observed an overall increase in enrollment for the 2025-2026 school year, with the largest increase observed at École des Beaux-Lacs and École Beauséjour.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING A TEACHERS' STRIKE

On September 29, 2025, the tentative agreement between the ATA and the Alberta government was rejected by ATA members by a vote of 89.5%. As a result, we expect a strike to be declared starting October 6, though the specific form of the work stoppage has yet to be confirmed.
