INFRASTRUCTURE

The trustees received an update on current infrastructure projects and engaged in discussions regarding future infrastructure priorities in preparation for the development of the Capital Plan.

ÉCOLE SAINTE-CATHERINE

Renovations at École Sainte-Catherine in Lac La Biche are in the final stages, with completion anticipated in May 2026.

Some representatives from the CSCE, AB Infrastructure, AB Capital Planning, and the Consultant hired by the CSCE visited École Beauséjour in Plamondon on February 13, 2026 to discuss the modernisation project.
